Regarding DTU Domain E-mail Deactivation & Reactivation Policy for Students

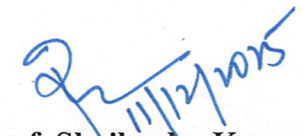
All admitted DTU students are hereby informed that their allotted DTU e-mail id will be discontinued/deleted after 03 months of declaration of their final year result.

Any request for temporary reactivation of the deleted DTU email may be submitted in Computer Centre within 10 days after deletion of DTU Email id. Request submitted after the stipulated time shall not be entertained.

Temporary reactivation of deleted DTU domain email Ids for a maximum duration of seven days upon written/email request from the concerned student/alumnus, solely for data retrieval and account updates.

Request for temporary reactivation of deleted DTU domain email-ID citing reason that they have submitted research paper in journal/conferences etc. and are waiting for final status of their **submitted research paper, may also be approved subject to recommendation & written confirmation** of their respective supervisor and HoD with comments that “student has submitted the research paper within the duration of his academic program and final status of research paper is yet to be communicated, hence, ex-student may be allowed for re-activation of DTU email id for ___ months.”
