*In the Second Round of Counselling, seats that become vacant due to withdrawals as on the date of counselling will first be offered to applicants who attended the First Round of Counselling but were not allotted a seat. In case vacancies still remain, the seats will be filled from applicants who were not invited for the First Round of Counselling.

**In the Spot Round of Counselling, after exhausting the list of applicants in the respective categories, seats available under conversion will be filled from all registered applicants. The norms for seat conversion are given at the end.

The following may be noted:

1. Participation in counselling does not entitle candidates to admission. A greater number of candidates than available seats have been invited to ensure no seats remain vacant. If a candidate is absent, the seat will be offered to the next candidate in the merit list.
2. **Candidates (for both second and spot round) must mark their attendance between 9 am to 11 am. Latecomers will not be eligible for the second and spot round of counselling.**

3. Seat allotment will be based on the merit of candidates who mark their attendance and according to the seat matrix provided in the Admission Brochure.
4. Candidates unable to attend physically can authorize a representative to participate in the counselling round and complete admission formalities. Representatives must carry a valid ID proof, a letter of authorization from the candidate, and original & photocopies of required documents.
5. **WITHDRAWAL/REFUND POLICY: NO FEE WILL BE REFUNDED IN THE CASE OF CANDIDATES WHO TAKE ADMISSION IN THE SPOT ROUND.**
6. Limited parking facilities will be available at the venue. Candidates are advised to consider alternative transportation options. The nearest Delhi Metro stations are Mansarovar Park on the Red Line and Karkardooma on the Blue/Pink Line.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF COUNSELLING

Candidates must present the following documents (**originals along with two photocopies**) in the specified order:

- (i) Demand draft of **Rs 53,700 (Rupees Fifty Three Thousand Seven Hundred only)** for the First Year Fee drawn in favour of “**Registrar DTU Admission East Delhi Campus**” payable at Delhi. (**NO OTHER MODE OF PAYMENT WILL BE ACCEPTED**)
- (ii) Print-out of the online application form for DTU’s M.A. (Economics) Programme
- (iii) Score Card of CUET (PG) – 2026
- (iv) All mark sheets and degree (provisional/final) of Graduation
- (v) Class X certificate/marksheet
- (vi) Class XII certificate/marksheet
- (vii) Certificates for reserved categories (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/KM/SG) or sub-categories (Defence/PwD), if applicable. **For OBC-NCL and EWS categories, certificates must be issued after March 31, 2026.** Submission of only acknowledgments indicating that new certificates are in process will not be accepted.

- (viii) The candidate's name on reserved category certificates and Graduation Marksheets/Degree must exactly match; otherwise, an affidavit confirming the discrepancy will be required.
- (ix) Medical fitness certificate

SEAT CONVERSION RULES FOR THE SPOT ROUND OF COUNSELLING

1. After exhausting the complete list of PwD and CW subcategories, if there are vacant seats, the vacant seats in these subcategories will be transferred to the respective main category (GEN/SC/ST/OBC/EWS).
2. After exhausting the complete list of registered SC, ST, OBC and EWS applicants, the conversion of vacant seats will be done in the Spot Round as per the following procedure:
 - i. If the complete list of ST category applicants is exhausted, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of SC category applicants, or vice versa, as per merit.
 - ii. If the complete list of EWS category applicants is exhausted, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of GEN category candidates, as per merit.
 - iii. If the complete list of OBC category applicants is exhausted, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled from the list of GEN category candidates, as per merit.
- iv. If the complete list of SC/ST category applicants is exhausted, then the remaining vacant seats under this category will be filled by creating equal number of additional seats in the GEN category, as per merit.
