Subject: Guidelines for opting MOOC subject for All PG programmes.

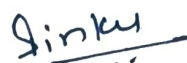
Delhi Technological University has been established as SWAYAM - NPTEL Local Chapter having Local Chapter ID (LC ID): 6497 and details of it are available at Website Link: <https://nptel.ac.in/localchapter/details?page=iclist>

The guidelines for opting MOOC courses for all PG programmes, DTU are as under:

1. Students are required to visit <http://onlinecourses.nptel.ac.in/> and select YES to the question 'Are you part of a Local Chapter'. The University name shall be correctly chosen as Delhi Technological University from the dropdown. Select 'Student' when portal prompts for Profession.
2. The students are advised to check last date of MOOC Course registration from time to time, before submission.

4. Students admitted in A.Y. 2021-22 onwards are allowed to earn a maximum of 16 credits towards elective courses through MOOC platform. These credits can be earned from SWAYAM/NPTEL courses only.
5. NPTEL offers a variety of courses which include core, elective and multidisciplinary courses. The Courses registered by students from their respective discipline would be considered for credits alongwith due approval of Departmental BoS (Board of Studies).
6. To complete credits online MOOC Courses through SWAYAM/NPTEL, department must ascertain the relevance of subject duly approved by the BOS of the concerned Department and a hard copy of the same may be submitted to the Examination Branch for necessary action and a copy to Dean (Acad-PG) for information.
7. The duration of the SWAYAM/NPTEL courses for consideration of credits is as under: -
 - a. Courses of minimum duration of 12 weeks are to be registered for electives. 4 credits per course shall be awarded on successful completion of each course.
 - b. Courses of minimum duration of 8 weeks are to be registered for 2 credits. However, students are allowed to register for courses of more than 8 weeks subject to the condition that maximum credits earned would be counted as 2 only for such courses.
8. The MOOCs to be registered by the students should not be same/similar to Courses already completed/likely to be completed during the programme of study.
9. Students are required to NPTEL/SWAYAM courses using their respective email id of DTU domain. This email id is unique to a student and cannot be shared by multiple students.
10. The students have to register and appear in person for a proctored exam to get a certificate from SWAYAM/NPTEL.
11. The percentage marks obtained as mentioned in certificate from SWAYAM/NPTEL shall be converted to letter grade as per the University norms.
12. The departmental MOOC coordinators shall verify the credentials of the certificates obtained by the students of their respective departments.

13. While opting for the MOOC course, student has to ensure that a certificate is issued after successful completion from the concerned platform.
14. Students may contact the MOOC Coordinators of their respective departments for the guidance.
